2. The proceedings were opened with a prayer conducted by Hon. speaker

4. **Communication from the chair;**

**5. Election of deputy speaker;**

The ballot box was opened in the full view of the Assembled House and voting commenced thereon.

At the conclusion of the voting, the designated clerks counted the votes at the table of the House. The Speaker announced the results of the first ballot as follows:-

- i. Hon. James Mutunga Munuve - 8 votes
- ii. Hon. Jehoshaphat Nzamba James- 9 votes
- iii. Hon. Emeritus Kasee Musya - 29 votes
- iv. Hon. Philip Nguli- 6 votes
- v. Spoilt votes - nil

And there being no candidate obtaining the required two-thirds majority, the Honorable Members proceeded to cast a second ballot. After the process was over, the ballot box was opened and a count taken by the designated clerks. The Speaker announced the votes as follows:-
