The Chair made the following communications;

Honorable members, I have received the following letters which reads as follows;

- i. H.E the Governor during her address to the County Assembly on 3<sup>rd</sup> October, 2017 underscored the need for Consultations between the Executive Arm and the County Assembly. In line with that Spirit, H.E the Governor will hold a consultative Meeting with Members of the County Assembly (MCAs) from Monday 4<sup>th</sup> to Friday 8<sup>th</sup> December 2017 in Mombasa. The agenda of the Meeting will include

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Presentations of the Ministerial Short term plans, the new guidelines for Community Level Infrastructure Development Programme (CLIDP) among others.

The purpose of this letter is to invite you to this meeting .Secondly, it is to request you to inform the honorable members of the County Assembly (MCAs) and urge them to attend the Meeting.

- ii. As you are aware, section 26 (2) of the Public Officer Ethics Act, 2013 requires each state or public officer to, once every two years, submit to their relevant responsible Commission a declaration of income, assets and liabilities of him /herself, spouse(s) and dependent children under the age of 18 years.

In addition, section 27 requires all person joining public service to make initial declaration within 30 days of becoming a state or public officer and final declarations within 30 days of ceasing to hold state or public office.

The Commission therefore notifies that 2017 is a declaration year and all state and public officers will be expected to submit their declarations to the Responsible Commissions before 31st December 2017. Further, it is expected that all persons elected or appointed to state or public offices shall make their initial declarations and those exiting public office make their final declarations.

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Please draw the attention of the state and public officers under your jurisdiction that failure to submit declarations is a criminal offence under section 32 of the Act which renders to a non-compliant officer, upon conviction, liable to, a fine not exceeding one million shillings or imprisonment for a term not exceeding one year or both; and could constitute a breach of chapter six of the Constitution.

EACC will monitor the declaration exercise and from time to time take such measures as may be necessary to enforce the law.
