1. The House assembled at Thirty minutes past Two O'clock.
2. The proceedings were opened with a prayer.
3. **PRESIDING** -Hon. Speaker.
4. **REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE COUNTY ASSEMBLY**

(Chairperson, the Committee of the Whole County Assembly)

The Chairperson Committee of the Whole County Assembly made the following communication;

Hon Speaker,

I wish to report that the House was considering Clause 5(1) in the Committee of the Whole House and consideration of the same was not finalized as voting to either accommodate or defeat the Governor's concerns, as required by Standing Order 134(5), did not take place.

There were 44 Members in the House and I directed that the Division bell be rung for 5 minutes. Before I put the question on this Clause, Wiper Party members requested for time to consult, which I allowed.

The Bell was rung again, and after 10 Minutes, there were 19 Members in the House, comprising of NARC Party and Independent Members. Wiper Party Members were not in the House and chaos had already begun erupting.

As stated above, no roll call voting took place in adherence to the provisions of Standing Order 69.

Standing Order 69(3) requires that Speaker (Chair of Committee of Whole House) to put the question again, and direct the Clerk to call out the names of Members in alphabetical order in the presence of tellers.

Under Standing Order 69(2), each Members' name is called out, rises in his or her place and declares assent or dissent to the question by stating "I vote Yes" or "I vote No" or "I Abstain" or uses sign language.

Further, Standing Order 69(3) requires that after the Clerk has read the last name in the Division list, the tellers present the results to the Speaker (Chair of Committee of Whole House) who then announces the result of the vote to the County Assembly.

Hence, consideration of Clause 5(1) was not finalized for the following reasons:

- i) The question was not put;
- ii) Each Member did not vote individually; and
- iii) No results were announced.

As such, the Memorandum still stands to be considered to conclusion by the Committee of the Whole House.

I therefore seek leave for the Committee of the Whole House to sit another day to finalize consideration of the Memorandum.
