**FURTHER NOTING THAT**, there have been various publications circulating in the social media portraying this House negatively;

**CONCERNED THAT**, there has been public outcry regarding equalization in development in Kitui County which has led to marginalization of various Wards and was one of the key issues to be discussed during the consultative meeting;

**THIS HOUSE RESOLVES THAT:**

- i) Each Honourable Member to be given a copy of the official communication from the Governor about the abortive invitation;
- ii) The Office of Speaker to write to the Governor demanding a written apology to this Honourable House;
- iii) The Committee on Procedure and Rules to formulate rules of engagement between the County Executive and the County Assembly to ensure that in future, similar incidents do not occur;
- iv) This House to urgently formulate a Ward Equalization Fund of at least 30% of the annual development budget which will ensure equalization of development among the Wards;
- v) Pursuant to Article 195(1) and (2) of the Constitution, this House fast tracks the formation of the Committee on Powers and Privileges to investigate the matter of malicious publications and allegations in the County;
