AWARE THAT, the institution plays an important role in human resource management and career development in our county.

COGNISANT THAT, there is a loud public outcry in the way the institution has conducted its affairs in a manner that has rendered the reputation of the institution wanting.

CONCERNED THAT, there has been an ongoing recruitment exercise by the aforementioned Board, which has further catalyzed the public outcry.

DETERMINED THAT, it is the mandate of this Assembly to correct the situation.

PURSUADED THAT, it is the duty of the Assembly to ensure that Articles 10 and 232 of the Constitution of Kenya are adhered to by all entities of the County Government including Kitui County Public Service Board (KCPSB).

This house resolves:

- a) To constitute an ad-hoc committee to conduct an inquiry on the affairs of the Board, and report back in a month's time, considering the following;
 - i. Total number of employees since inception in March, 2013
 - ii. Job sharing in all the 40 wards
 - iii. Total number of youths employed in the County
 - iv. Gender representation (Male/Female) in each ward
 - v. The cadre (Job Group) in each ward
 - vi. The physically challenged in each ward
 - vii. Regional representation
- b) To suspend all recruitment exercises by the Board during the period of this inquiry
- c) That the Board furnishes the ad hoc committee with:-

 - i. all employment policies, records, and practices of personnel including those of; County Secretaries, Chief Executive Officers, Deputy Directors, and Assistant Directors
 - ii. any other information as may be required by the Committee to shed light on the matter under consideration.
