FURTHER AWARE THAT, pursuant to Standing Order No. 188 the Committee on Implementation was established on 11th October, 2018 with the mandate to scrutinize and examine whether House resolutions have been implemented, degree of implementation, amongst others functions;

CONCERNED THAT since inception of the Second County Assembly this House has adopted various motions, reports, petitions, amongst others but has no substantive report or update on the implementation status of its resolutions, notwithstanding that the said Committee has been in Office for over eight (8) months;

FURTHER CONCERNED THAT, this House is apprehensive that the County Executive if unchecked may implement House resolutions differently from what has been passed by this County Assembly;

THIS HOUSE HEREBY RESOLVES THAT the Committee on Implementation should:

1. Scrutinize and examine:
 - a) the implementation status of House resolutions passed during the Second County Assembly;
 - b) whether legislation passed by both the First Assembly and Second Assembly has been operationalized and the degree of operationalization;with a view of reporting and updating the County Assembly on the implementation status of the said resolutions and legislation;
2. Table its report on the implementation status of County Assembly resolutions and legislation within 90 days of adoption of this Motion;
3. Be Reporting to the House on implementation status of County Assembly resolutions on a quarterly basis.
