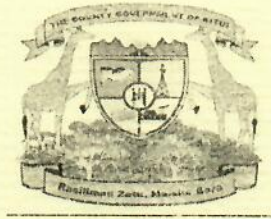

COMMUNICATION AS RELATES TO THE KITUI COUNTY CORPORATION  
BILL, 2018

Honourable Members,

Standing order no. 116 provides that no bill shall be introduced in the County Assembly unless such Bill together with the memorandum of objects and reasons has been published in the County Gazette and Kenya Gazette and unless a period of 14 days has ended from the date of the said publishing.

Honourable Members,

The Kitui County Corporation Bill, 2018 was published in the Kenya Gazette on 7<sup>th</sup> November 2018. Due to the urgency of the Bill, the County Assembly Business Committee resolved that a motion be moved to shorten the maturity period in accordance with the provisions of standing order no. 116.


The motion was moved on a sitting held on Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> November, 2018 and the question on the motion proposed. However, during the debate of the said motion, Honourable Stephen Ileve Katana while on a point of order under standing order no. 32 (1), claimed that the House lacked quorum. Upon determination of the fact, the Honourable Deputy Speaker who was presiding

the sitting at the time, thereby adjourned the House without giving a directive on the motion.

Honourable Members,

Arising therefrom, the County Assembly Business Committee is therefore supposed to reschedule further debate on the motion in consultation with the mover.
