COMMUNICATION FROM THE CHAIR AS RELATES TO WEALTH DECLARATION FOR PUBLIC OFFICERS

Honorable Members,

I kindly draw your attention to the provisions of Chapter Six of our Constitution on Leadership and Integrity which provides for the guiding principle of leadership and integrity for public officers. Section 26 of the Public Officers Ethics Act, 2003 provides that each state or public officer is required once every two years to submit to the responsible Commission for the public officer a declaration of the income, assets and liabilities of himself, his spouse or spouses and dependent children under the age of 18 years. Section 26(2) of the Act provides that the declaration shall be in the form set out in the Schedule and shall include the information required by the form.

Honorable Members,

It is important to note that your previous declarations were accordingly done in 2017. The year 2019 is a declaration year so all public officials are required to make declarations. The deadline for submission is 31st December, 2019. Therefore Honorable Members, find in your pigeon holes, the said declarations.



forms to fill in the information required. You should submit the duly filled forms
to the Office of the Principal Human Resource Officer before the set dead line.

Honorable Members,

Failure to submit the declarations is a criminal offence according to the
Constitution and makes one liable to a fine not exceeding Sh1 million or one
year imprisonment. I hereby urge you to expeditiously undertake this process
bearing in mind the timelines.
