COMMITTEE MEMBERSHIP**

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## **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

The County Assembly of Kitui (CAK) customized and adopted its new Standing Orders on 1<sup>st</sup> July 2015. As such, towards the beginning of a new (fourth) session, the leadership of the institution was inspired to instigate compliance in relevant areas.

The County Assembly Business Committee (CABC), Selection Committee (SC) and Party Whips proceeded to identify two such areas in need of compliance: “reconstituting” committees and “balancing” membership in committees.

Two strategies were adopted in order to attain set objectives:

1. Party whips and Selection Committee resolved to ***ensure all committees were in line with legal provisions*** as provided for in Standing Order (2015) Numbers; 152 to 157 and 190.
2. So as to ensure balanced membership in committees, the Selection Committee resolved that, ***each honorable member of the CAK should be a member of at-least “two” sectoral committees.***

The Selection Committee and Party Whips (also referred to as “the team” in this report) was able to “reconstitute” three standing committees. It was also able to re-organize eighteen select committees (seven standing and eleven sectoral) duly “balancing” and allocating each Honorable Member with at least three committees.

This report entails the team’s recommendations on the same.

## **PREFACE**

### **Mr. Speaker**

The County Assembly of Kitui (CAK) was constituted in April 2013. It was established after Kenyan general elections and principles of devolved governance stipulated in the Constitution of Kenya (2010) come into force.

### **Mr. Speaker**

After establishment, the Assembly initially created seventeen (17) committees to assist it in its mandates of budget approval, representation, legislation and oversight. Committees were subsequently increased to twenty-one (21) in May 2015 so as to accommodate and capably perform the various “routine” and “sectoral” works of the Assembly.

### **Mr. Speaker**

The CAK and its Honorable Members identified two major challenges on Committee Work that needed to be addressed moving towards the Fourth Session. These challenges were identified as:

1. Inadequate time schedules allocated for Committees Sessions, (some committees got more time than other), and;
2. Lack of quorum during committee meetings as Honorable Members (and Committee Clerks) were expected to be in different meetings at the same time.

Additionally, the County Assembly Business Committee, Party Whips and the Selection Committee in an informal meeting on 2<sup>nd</sup> December 2015, found that some Committees were illegal constituted and needed to be reconstituted, (as per the newly formulated Standing Orders).

### **Mr. Speaker**

In that meeting, it was resolved that the Selection Committee together with Party Whips were to expeditiously address the above stated matters through “Reconstituting Committees and Balancing Committee Membership”. The team was thereby allocated three (3) days, from 3<sup>rd</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup> December 2015 to meet so as to address the matter. The meeting was held at Pride Inn Hotel, Nairobi, Kenya.

### **Mr. Speaker**

The primary objectives of the three-day meeting were:

1. *To enable consultations between the County Assembly Business Committee (CABC), Selection Committee (S.C.) and Party Whips, so as...*
2. *To “Reconstitute Committees” and “Balance Committee Membership” for the County Assembly.*

## Mr. Speaker

Two strategies were adopted to attain these objectives:

1. The Committee resolved that it would utilize the newly formulated Assembly Standing Orders, to ***ensure all committees were in line with legal provisions***. Duly, the committee familiarized itself with relevant Standing Orders (2015) on ‘committees’ and ‘membership’ (as stipulated in S.O. No. 152 to 157 and 190). Subsequently, it created a list presenting total number of each member’s committees (Annex 5.1), and compared it to the list displaying membership of committees.
2. So as to ensure balanced membership provisions were met, the committee resolved that, ***each honorable member of the CAK should be a member of at-least “two” sectoral committees***. (See Annex 5.3)

## Mr. Speaker

Kindly note that provisions on Balanced Membership for Select Committee’s stipulate the need for:

1. Gender Balance,
2. Party Proportional Representation,
3. No member should have more than 3 Sectoral Committees, and
4. Committees should comply with provision on membership limit numbers

## 1. COMMITTEE FINDINGS

There various types of County Assembly Committees: Ad Hoc, Standing and Sectoral Committees.

- **Standing Committees** execute business of routine/in-house.
- **Ad Hoc Committees** are formed to investigate, study, and make recommendations on issues that need consideration and solutions.
- **Sectoral Committees** investigate and inquire into activities and administration of the County Executive as constituted subject to the Fourth Schedule of Constitution of Kenya 2010.<sup>1</sup>

In the CAK, its two major types of select committees are comprised of “standing” and “sectoral” committees.

### 1.1. Standing Committees

#### 1.1.1. Reconstitution of Committees in National Parliament:

Key highlights that herald commencement of fourth sessions in most Parliament and County Assemblies is the expected reconstitution of key House Committees. For example, in the Parliament of Kenya, the National Assembly (N.A.) expects to reconstitute the following committees:

- House Business Committee (N.A. Standing Order 171(2))*
- Committee on Appointments (N.A. Standing Order 204(2))*
- Public Accounts Committee (N.A. Standing Order 205(6))*
- Public Investment Committee (N. A. Standing Order 206 (6))*
- Budget and Appropriations Committee (N. A. Standing Order 207(4))*
- Committee of Privileges*

Political parties represented in the House are expected to nominate Members to the aforementioned Committees, and forward the proposals for approval by the House.<sup>2</sup>

#### 1.1.2. S.O. 151 – County Assembly Business Committee (CABC)

Membership should consist of the Speaker (Chair), Leader of Majority, Leader of Minority, NOT less than eleven (11) or more than seventeen (17) members, inclusive of whips and deputy speaker (V/chair). **The County Assembly Parties in Consultation with the Assembly should reconstitute membership after every session. Our Committee has 17 members.**

#### 1.1.3. S.O. 152 – Selection Committee (S.C.)

Membership should consist of the Leader of Majority (Chair), Leader of Minority (V/Chair), NOT less than eleven (11) or more than nineteen (19) members. **The County Assembly Parties in Consultation with the Assembly should nominate membership to this committee. Our Committee has 15 members.**

*1.1.4. S.O. 184 – Appointment Committee*

Membership should consist of the Speaker (Chair), Leader of Majority (V/Chair), Leader of Minority, NOT more than **three (3) members nominated by CABC** (Party Proportional). **The County Assembly Parties in Consultation with the Assembly should reconstitute membership after three years. Our Committee has 6 members.**

*1.1.5. S.O. 185 – Public Investment and Accounts Committee (PIAC)*

Membership should consist of a Chair and not more than four members. **The Selection Committee should reconstitute membership after three years. Our Committee has 5 members and its term has expired.**

*1.1.6. S.O. 186 – Budget and Appropriations Committee (BAC)*

Membership should consist of a Chair and not more than eight (8) members (members should not be chairs of other committees). **The Selection Committee should reconstitute membership after three years. Our Committee has 9 members and its term has expired.**

*1.1.7. S.O. 187 – Procedure and Rules Committee*

Membership should consist of the Speaker, Chair of Chairs and NOT more than three (3) other members. **Our Committee has 5 members**

*1.1.8. S.O. 188/189 – Implementation & Delegated Legislation Committees*

No provision on membership is stipulated in the Standing Orders. **Our Committee has eleven (11) members.**

*1.1.9. S.O. 191 – Liaison Committee*

Membership should consist of a Chair of Chairs and all Chairpersons of Assembly Committee's. **Our Committee has seventeen (17) members.**

## **1.2. Sectoral Committees**

Establishing Sectoral Committees is guided by the; Fourth Schedule of the Constitution (2010) and Second Schedule of the County Assembly Standing Orders. With the formulation of the new County Assembly of Kitui Standing Orders (2015), there are seven key principles on establishing Sectoral Committees (S.O. 152 – 157):

*1.2.1. Gender Balance*

*1.2.2. Party Proportional Representation*

*1.2.3. Not less than 9 (or) more than 11 members per committee*

*1.2.4. No member should have more than 3 sectoral committees*

*1.2.5. Odd number membership*

*1.2.6. Half of members form quorum in meetings*

*1.2.7. Sectoral committee members are nominated by the CABC in consultation with Parties at the commencement of every County Assembly (S.O. 190)*

### 1.3. Key Committees Findings on Sectoral Committees

Utilizing the new County Assembly of Kitui Standing Orders (2015), the Selection Committee conducted an inquiry on how many committees and members complied with the above principles.

#### 1.3.1. Identified Sectoral Committees with issues:

- *Agriculture, Water and Irrigation (14 members – remove three)*
- *Basic Education, Training and Skills Development (13 members – remove two)*
- *Lands, Infrastructure and Urban Development (13 members – remove two)*
- *Environment, Energy, Mining, and Natural Resources (12 members – remove one)*
- *Culture, Youth, Sports and Social Services (10 members – remove or add one)*
- *Health and Sanitation (10 members – remove or add one)*
- *Administration, and Coordination of County Affairs (12 members – remove one)*

#### 1.3.2. Members identified with more than three Sectoral Committees: (See Annex 5.1)

- *Hon. Bernard Munyasia (5 Sectoral Committees)*
- *Hon. Hussein Mwandia (5 Sectoral Committees)*
- *Hon. Jennifer Munuve (4 Sectoral Committees)*
- *Hon. Jemmimah Mbiti (4 Sectoral Committees)*

#### 1.3.3. Newly Formed Committees as of May 2015

- *Labor and Social Welfare – A Sectoral Committee*
- *Justice and Legal Affairs – A Standing Committee*
- *Powers and Privileges Committee (S.O. 171 no provision on membership number)*
- *Note: All new committees were constituted of nine (9) members*

## 2. COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATIONS

The committee made the following changes so as to **reconstitute** and **balance** membership of committees: (Find the compiled list of new Committee Members Annex 5.2)

### 2.1. Standing Committees

#### 2.1.1. Public Accounts and Investments Committee

The committee was to be **reconstituted** as per S.O 185 (4). The team resolved to **retain this committee membership** as designated previously. (Refer to annex 5.2 page 20)

#### 2.1.2. Budget and Appropriations Committee

The committee was to be **reconstituted** as per S.O 186 (4), as well as (S.O. 152 – 157) so as observe party proportional representation. The team reconstituted this committee by **retaining all other members and discharging the membership of Hon. Jackson Mwanduka** of CORD Coalition and **nominating inclusion of Hon. Kalovo Musau** of Jubilee Coalition. CORD Coalition further **discharged the membership of Hon. Irene Muvea and replaced her with Hon. Jennifer Munuve**. (Refer to annex 5.2 page 20)

#### 2.1.3. Implementation and Delegated Legislation Committee

The team resolved that **this committee should be split into two committees** as per S.O. 188 and 189. It vowed to seek further guidance on the matter. However, to balance membership of the current committee, the team nominated the **inclusion of Hon. Kalovo Musau** as part of the committee's membership. Additionally, **Hon. Grogan Mbivi to be discharged from the committee swapping with Hon. Hussein Mwandia of the Finance and Planning Committee. CORD Coalition discharged the membership of Hon. Peter Kilonzo and replaced with Hon. Colleta Kimanzi.**

#### 2.1.4. Justice and Legal Affairs Committee

The Fourth Schedule of the Constitution of Kenya (2010) and the Second Schedule of the County Assembly of Kitui Standing Orders (2015) do not indicate if this committee is a Sectoral Committee. It was thereby proposed that the *Procedure and Rule Committee* should provide a clarification if this committee was a sectoral committee, and subsequently, should it be considered as one (sectoral committee), an amendment to the Standing Orders should be immediately effected to indicate the same. The team resolved to reserve the committee as a Standing Committee, and proceeded to increase its membership from nine (9) to eleven (11). Members **nominated into this committee** were: **Hon. Francis Mwalili and Hon. Alex Nganga. CORD Coalition discharged the membership of Hon. Jane Mutua and Hon. Mwendwa Munyoki and replaced with Hon. John Nyamai and Hon. Mwove Kinyala.**

### 2.1.5. Powers and Privileges Committee

The Committee was constituted as per S.O. 171 but has no provision on membership numbers. It has nine (9) members. In order to balance membership within **CORD Coalition, the party discharged the membership of Hon. Titus Kasinga and replaced with Hon. Vestantina Chawana.**

## 2.2. Sectoral Committees

### 2.2.1. Agriculture, Water and Irrigation Committee

This committee had fourteen (14) members, three (3) more than the membership limits stipulated in the S.O. 152 to 157. The team discharged the membership of three members from this committee. **Members discharged** from the committee were: **Hon. Mwove Kinyala, Hon. Hussein Mwandia and Hon. Bernard Munyasia.** The committee is now balanced with a maximum limit of eleven (11) members.

### 2.2.2. Basic Education, Training and Skills Development Committee

This committee had thirteen (13) members, two (2) more than the membership limits stipulated in the S.O. 152 to 157. The team discharged the membership of two members from this committee.

- i. **Members discharged** from the committee: **Hon. Colleta Kimanzi and Hon. Rhoda Wambua**
- ii. To balance members Jubilee Coalition **discharged Hon. Jane Muli's membership to the committee, and nominating Hon. Kalovo Musau as a replacement.**
- iii. **CORD Coalition discharged Hon. Samuel Ikunga's membership to the committee, and nominating Hon. Rhoda Wambua as a replacement.**

The committee is now balanced with a maximum limit of eleven (11) members.

### 2.2.3. Lands, Infrastructure and Urban Development Committee

This committee had thirteen (13) members, two (2) more than the membership limits stipulated in the S.O. 152 to 157. The team discharged the membership of two members from this committee. **Members discharged** from the committee were: **Hon. Hussein Mwandia and Hon. Stephen Kithuka.** The committee is now balanced with a maximum limit of eleven (11) members.

### 2.2.4. Environment, Energy, Mining and Natural Resources Committee

This committee had twelve (12) members, one (1) more than the membership limits stipulated in the S.O. 152 to 157. The team discharged the membership of one member from this committee: **Member discharged from the committee was Hon. Allan Kavindi. Jubilee Coalition discharged the membership of Hon. Kalovo Musau and replaced with Hon. Catherine Kasimu. Hon. Titus Mbiti's membership to the committee was also discharged with Hon. Phoebe Kisee nominated as a replacement so as to provide gender balance in the committee.** The committee is now balanced with a maximum limit of eleven (11) members.

#### 2.2.5. Finance and Planning Committee

This committee had eleven (11) members and within the **membership limits** stipulated in the Standing Orders. However, the team resolved to discharge the membership of **Hon. Phoebe Kisee to this committee, and replace her with Hon. Titus Mbiti.** Additionally, **Hon. Hussein Mwandia to be discharged from the committee swapping him with Hon. Grogan Mbivi of the Implementation and Delegated Legislation Committee.**

#### 2.2.6. Culture, Youth, Sports and Social Services Committee

This committee had ten (10) members and in contradiction to the membership regulation of **odd numbers** stipulated in the S.O. 152 - 157. The team resolved to nominate the **inclusion of Hon. Jackson Mwanduka to the membership of this committee.** CORD Coalition further **discharged the membership of Hon. Jennifer Munuve and replaced her with Hon. Irene Muvea.**

#### 2.2.7. Health and Sanitation Committee

This committee had ten (10) members and in contradiction to the membership regulation of **odd numbers** stipulated in the S.O. 152 - 157. The team resolved to nominate the **inclusion of Hon. Stansilous Mulongo to the membership of this committee.** CORD Coalition further **discharged the membership of Hon. Jamuhuri Mwangi and replaced her with Hon. Nelson Kitema.**

#### 2.2.8. Administration and Coordination of County Affairs Committee

This committee had twelve (12) members, one (1) more than the membership limits stipulated in the S.O. 152 to 157. The team resolved to discharge the membership of a member from this committee: **Member discharged from the committee was Hon. Jennifer Munuve. Hon. Jemimah Mbiti's membership was also discharged with Hon. Jane Mutua nominated as a replacement.** The committee is now balanced with a maximum limit of eleven (11) members.

#### 2.2.9. Tourism Committee

This committee had nine (9) members. The team resolved to increase the membership of this committee by two (2) members: **Nominated for inclusion to the committee were: Hon. Peter Mwikya and Hon. Irene Muvea. Cord coalition balanced their membership by discharging Hon. Bernard Munyasya's membership to the committee and Hon. Jamuhuri Mwangi was nominated as a replacement.** The committee is now balanced with a maximum limit of eleven (11) members.

#### 2.2.10. Labor and Social Welfare Committee

This committee had nine (9) members. The team resolved to increase the membership of this committee by two (2) members. **Members nominated for inclusion to the committee were: Hon. Ruth Kinyumu and Hon. Mwendwa Munyoki.** The committee is now balanced with a maximum limit of eleven (11) members.

### **3. COMMITTEES BEYOND SELECTION COMMITTEE MANDATE**

Party whips took charge to consolidate the following recommendations from their respective members:

#### **3.1. County Assembly Business Committee (CABC)**

**Nomination of members to this committee is executed by County Assembly parties and approved by the County Assembly.** The committee's term expired at the end of the Third Session and is to be **reconstituted** as per Standing Order No. 151.

#### **3.2. Selection Committee**

**Nomination of members to this committee is executed by County Assembly parties and approved by the County Assembly.** The committee's current membership is fifteen (15) members with a limit of nineteen (19) members. **Party Whips** recommended that membership should be increased from 15 to seventeen (17) so as to enable balanced membership **subject to the approval of the County Assembly:**

- i. Members proposed for **inclusion** were: **Hon. Rhoda Wambua and Hon. Allan Kavindi**
- ii. As at 15<sup>th</sup> February 2015, Jubilee Coalition proceeded to balance its members by **discharging Hon. Catherine Kasimu and Hon. Jane Muli's membership to the committee, and nominating Hon. Johnray Ngava and Hon. Kalovo Musau as replacements.**
- iii. **CORD Coalition** proceeded to balance its members by **discharging Hon. Peter Kilonzo, Hon. Nzyoni Manguye, Hon. Titus Mbiti and Hon. Stephen Kithuka's membership to the committee, and nominating Hon. Jackson Mwanduka, Hon. Veesi Musyoka, Hon. Dominic Kauthi and Hon. Felix Kinuva as replacements.**

#### **3.3. Appointments Committee**

**County Assembly Business Committee executes nomination of members to this committee.** Appointment committee's term expired at the end of the Third Session and is to be **reconstituted** as per S.O 184.

#### 4. CONCLUSION

The Party whips and Selection Committee have been able to “**reconstitute committees**” and “**balance membership**” of committees. This team reconstituted two standing committees and further recommends re-organized membership of eighteen select committees (seven standing and eleven sectoral), so as to allocate each Honorable Member with at least three committees with two of those being sectoral committees.

The team now wishes to request the County Assembly Business Committee (CABC) to ensure:

- 4.1. That each of the eleven (11) **sectoral committees gets at-least two concurrent sittings per week**
- 4.2. That each of the ten (10) **standing committees gets at-least two sittings per month**, except for the County Assembly Business Committee, and/or as it shall be otherwise resolved by the County Assembly

This will enable Honorable Members to comfortably attain at least four (4) committee sittings per week.

The team also wishes to request fellow Honorable members to consider the matters:

- 4.3. That the Procedure and Rules Committee should give guidance on the mandate of the Justice and Legal Affairs Committee
- 4.4. That the Implementation and Delegated Legislation should be split into two committees as provided for in S.O. 188 and 189.
- 4.5. That the new formed Delegated Legislation Committee should be part of the Justice and Legal Affairs Committee

The team lastly wishes to present these findings and recommendations to fellow members for subsequent debate and approval.
