to talk to us at about 10.30am, so you can have a cup of tea, you can chat but let's meet at 10.30 am. I am sure you have a lot of interest in that document.

I don't want them to come and find that we are not there all of us. Let's all be here and talk to them. In the afternoon they will be talking to the Governor. Instead of....

.....about the case in court, although they wanted to be briefed in a Kamukunji, I will instead brief you in this formal session. The judge was not available yesterday and the case did not take off but I understand the mention of the case was set for 16th. that is, next week and from there the court will give a direction on how to proceed. I am told the 16th will not be a hearing date but a mention date. Unless I was not properly briefed, and from there the court will give direction. That is where we are.

That is all I have to say. You can wait for the next 40 minutes so that we can meet with the Transitional Authority. Anybody with anything or clarification you want? Thank you.
