Hon. Kilonzo: Thank you Mr Speaker Sir, I beg to give a notice of Motion:

THAT, aware that there has been intensive charcoal burning within most parts of Kitui County coupled with very high demand and readily available market which has led to high charcoal exportation outside this County; aware that this uncontrolled activity has adversely and negatively impacted to our environment, causing environmental degradation, air pollution, Global warming and reducing chances of rain by destroying catchment areas; concerned that environmental conservation has perpetual and positive contributions to our livelihoods for generations and generations; concerned that this human activity has devastated our environment to an alarming state; further aware, that charcoal business has been a source of income to over 30% of our population in this County where majority live below the poverty line; appreciating provisions of our

constitution chapter five part 2 Article 69 Section 1 Subsection (a) to (g) on state obligation in respect of the environment; noting provisions in the same Article 69 section 1 Subsection (f) to (h) and Subsection 2 in the same Article.

This Assembly urges with immediate effect that the County Executive to establish a sustainable and controlled charcoal production and immediately come up with strong regulations and mitigating measures to this Industry.

Mr Speaker Sir, I wish to give the notice.

The Speaker: Very well; the notice has been given. The House business Committee shall allocate time.

The Speaker: Now, Honourable Members, we have come to the end of our business this afternoon and I want to take this opportunity, first to congratulate the new members of this house.

(Applause)

The Speaker: Congratulations, it is good to be a winner at one time; you are the winners this afternoon and you are the focus of attention this afternoon, so congratulations and you feel good and great.

Secondly I want also to take the opportunity – the new members to welcome you to this house. This is August Honourable House; its different from maybe what you have known, some of you in the past, some of you like the Honourable Ndumbu, Mbandi, Colleta and so forth. Those who have been in this game before; it is completely different from the Councils you were serving before. This is an Honourable House.

(Applause)

The Speaker: And I want to repeat; this is an Honourable House; you are Honourable members of this house, and this is an Honourable House and you must behave, speak... everything you do as a member of this house – inside and outside- you must be honourable if you want to be accorded the dignity of this house. It's a replica, a complete replica in a lesser scale of Parliament; whatever happens in Parliament – the manners,

the behaviours, the transaction of business is also done here. And therefore we welcome you. And as we welcome you into this house, we have said this before with those who are already here; it's an Honourable House, and when you come here you must behave like an Honourable Member and you'll be respected.

Having said that, why should it be honourable? Why should it be different from what it was before? Because your work here is largely different from what you were doing. Previously in the Council, you were doing... you know, certain project implementation, you were an administration, you were a legislator... you were a jack of all trades, and a master of none. But here, you are not a Jack of all trades; you have specific responsibilities by the constitution. You don't guess what you are going to do here; it all spelt out in the constitution what your duties are here. And if you follow them, you'll be an Honourable Member and you'll have no problem with your...

Your first and foremost duty here is to represent the interests of Kitui County in this house. I'm talking to the new members – to represent the interests of Kitui County as a whole in this house; you do not represent any ward, you do not represent any constituency. You are appointed, nominated to represent the interests of Kitui County; that is very very important for you to know. Don't go back to your ward and start doing ward work. No! Wadi iko na mwenyewe! Who has been given the mandate by the people of that ward to do what he is supposed to do in this house.

(Applause)

The Speaker: Yours is to represent the interests; to address yourself to the interests of the entire county. Whatever concerns this county, you are supposed to take keen interest.

Secondly, you are in this house to make laws and regulations for this county. *Sheria ya* this county; how this county will be governed, how this county will be run; the necessary enabling laws and regulations for this county will be made by you here in this house to complement the constitution and the national laws, but those laws specifically, like you have seen Honourable Wambua... Sorry Honourable Kilonzo... my apologies. Honourable Kilonzo, he wants charcoal to be regulated for the benefit of this county, for the benefit of the people of this county and in the interest of the environment. *Hiyo*, that is a Motion to make regulation about our charcoal; the one which has been used by everybody in every manner, you know, destroying the environment.

Your second duty is to make laws for this county, and the third duty and equally important is what we call oversight role of the executive.

Whatever the Governor and the entire executive in the Governor's department offices, whatever they are doing in terms of implementing projects, in terms of utilising the finances, in terms of what they are supposed to do by law in this county, you are supposed to oversee by making sure they do what they are supposed to do, they do it right and they do it on time. If they don't, you are the people to question them; "why did you do it wrong" "why did you do it this and that way?" you have that Parliamentary legal oversight role, the way Parliament oversees the executive in Nairobi, you'll be doing exactly the same with the government of the Governor here in Kitui.

And therefore those are very important functions: representing your county, making laws and overseeing the executive. You can't do those three important roles unless you are an Honourable Member, you can't. because in so doing you are supposed to be very honest; very honest, very honest, because you can't tell the executive *iko kitu hapo kwa jicho*, and you also have it. It will not be right. So you are supposed to be honourable, honest and you do things right. That calls for absolute... it is difficult for me to say it... for exemplary conduct of yourself and how you conduct your business both here and outside the house. In fact out there people will say "Oh, Honourable Muthui is passing there," "Honourable So is there," but if Honourable So and So is fighting out in the streets or *anakula kitu kingine ambacho ni kibaya*, will that be good for the interest of the house? Even if you are entertaining yourself somewhere, entertain yourself in an honourable manner. Isn't it? Don't just entertain yourself; whatever you are doing, you are a free citizen, you are free to do what everyone else is doing, but do it with a difference – in an honourable manner.

I don't want to dwell on many things, we'll be saying many things, we'll spend a lot of time with you, but if you want to be comfortable in this house, if you want to do what you are supposed to do in this house, well, *iko kitabu moja hapa*; there's a book you have to read, it's a bible here – Standing Orders. This book, make sure the Clerk gives you this book. Make sure you read it every night, every time you have a minute or two to spare so that you know what is inside here. Once you know what is inside here, you'll be a very effective Member of County Assembly because it's all here. There are other laws that you'll be told to read, which are also necessary for you to do your job, and the Clerk will give them to you. Please I urge you to get them and read them, but first master this one.

Now Honourable Members, with those few remarks, I will interrupt the business of the house, but before I do so, as soon as I finish and I leave the chamber, you'll remain seated; the Clerk of the Assembly has something to tell you. So don't move out; remain seated. But I have noted something which I may want to give a directive. We have three of our colleagues who

I'm sorry to replace you Bwana Mulongo, you'll have to find somewhere else to sit, but those three seats will be preserved for those three Members of the Assembly.
