**REPORT ON THE KITUI COUNTY VILLAGES BILL, 2014.**

**NOVEMBER 2014**

## **PREAMBLE**

**Mr. Speaker**, on 8<sup>th</sup> July, 2014 pursuant to Standing Order 133 (1)(2), a motion was moved to withdraw the Kitui County Villages Bill, 2014 since the public views had not been fully incorporated in the report. Thereafter, the Bill became the property of the Assembly.

**Mr. Speaker**, members of the Assembly collectively agreed on a formula of a population quota of 4,000 persons per village unit in order to guide the committee in their deliberations.

**Mr. Speaker**, on 6<sup>th</sup> August 2014, the committee began deliberations on the development of guidelines to be used in the establishment of village units in the Kitui County Villages Bill which included the population quota, geographical characteristics, population density, marginalization and other historical injustices. Other issues arising were the names of the villages units.

**Mr. Speaker**, the committee deliberated on a second criteria that took into consideration a margin of plus or minus thirty percent (30%) of the proposed population quota per village unit. The committee also deliberated on a third criteria that took into consideration a margin of plus or minus thirty five percent (35%) of the proposed population quota per village unit.

**Mr. Speaker**, members of the committee collectively agreed to follow a fourth criteria in the establishment of the village units which takes into consideration the geographical features, vastness of the area, historical injustices, marginalization among other key issues.

**Mr. Speaker**, pursuant to Standing Order 133 (3) this Bill was re-published on 29<sup>th</sup> October, 2014 and introduced in the House on 12<sup>th</sup> November 2014. The committee thereafter came up with additional recommendations putting into consideration public views.
