## THE KITUI COUNTY FINANCE BILL, 2016

A Bill for,

**AN ACT of the Kitui County Assembly to provide for the various taxes, rates fees and charges for goods, stock and services and for other revenue raising measures by the county government; and for matters incidental thereto**

ENACTED by the County Assembly of Kitui as follows-

### PART I- PRELIMINARY

#### Short title and commencement

1. This Act may be cited as the Kitui County Finance Act, 2016 and shall come into operation on such a date as the County Executive Member responsible for Finance, with the concurrence of the Governor, may appoint and different dates may be appointed for different provisions.

#### Object and purpose of the Act

2. This Act seeks to prescribe the rates of taxes, fees and charges for the assessment year 2016-2017, the rates at which taxes and other charges will be payable during the financial year 2016-2017 from properties which include land and buildings, businesses, markets, agricultural produce, outdoor advertisement, health services, vehicle parking, heritage sites, County parks, entertainment and mining and extraction activities.

### PART II- TAXES, FEES AND CHARGES PAYABLE AND RATES APPLICABLE

#### 3. Imposition, revision of taxes, rates, fees and charges

- 3.1. The taxes, fees and charges set out as per the different Schedules listed hereunder at the rates set out therein based on County Zones as indicated under the Columns defined by their economic potential:

3(1) (a) Schedule I – Property rates and rent Represent rates, rent and other related charges on properties.

3 (1) (b) Schedule II – Trade licenses and permits: These include licenses and permits under the Single Business Permit (SBP) regime, Advertising and promotion, Applications for approval of registration of private educational institutions, Sacco charges, Certificates for keeping pets in towns and Liquor Licenses.

3(1) (c) Schedule III – Charges for services and user fees: These are charges/fees on General user charges, Street parking, Barter market, Cess/Expert and User fees by county Ministries.

- 3(2) A person who wishes to carry out any of the activities, businesses or use county services /property listed under schedule I,II,III shall pay taxes ,fees charges payable and rates applicable therein.

3(3) (a) The County shall grant the relevant permits, licenses and or receipts upon payment of the fees prescribed in the relevant part of the applicable schedule.

(b) A license, permit or receipt issued under sub section 3(3)(a) shall be visibly displayed at the business premises at all times and or produces on request by an authorized county public officer.

- 3(4) The taxes, fees and charges applicable are payable to County Government of Kitui at the commencement of this Act.

3(5) Administration of taxes, fees and charges of items not included in the Schedules to this Act shall continue to apply under the existing by-laws of the defunct Municipal Council of Kitui, County Council of Kitui, County Council of Mwingi, and Town Council of Mwingi until such by-laws are specifically repealed by county legislation.

3(6) A person who contravenes any of the provisions of this section commits an offence under this Act.

#### **Directions, resolutions made under provisions of Local Governments Act**

4. (1) All directions, resolutions, orders and authorizations relating to financial management including the collection and administration of taxes, fees and charges given or issued by the defunct Municipal Council of Kitui, County Council of Kitui, County Council of Mwingi and Town Council of Mwingi and subsisting or valid immediately before the cessation of the application of the Local Government Act (Cap. 265) shall be deemed to have been given, issued or made by or under the authority of the county assembly until the expiry or repeal of those directions, resolutions, orders and authorizations on financial management and shall continue, with the necessary modifications, apply to the payment and the administration of the taxes, fees, charges and other levies under this Act.
- (2) The provisions of subsection (1) do not apply to the specific respective amounts payable in respect of taxes, fees, charges or other levies provided for under part II of this Act.

#### **Repeal of Public Finance Management Act, transitional and saving provisions.**

5. (1) Notwithstanding the repeal of the Public Financial Management Act 2012, the provisions of that Act shall remain in force and effect for purposes of the assessment and collection of any tax and the recovery of any penalty, payable under the Act and outstanding at the date upon which such repeal becomes effective.
- (2) Any subsidiary legislation made under the repealed Act in force at the commencement of this Act shall remain in force, so far as it is not inconsistent with this Act, until subsidiary legislation with respect to the same matter is made under this Act.

### **PART III- FINES AND PENALTIES**

6. This part includes specific amounts for fines and penalties on Property rates and rent, Trade licenses and permits and services and user fees.

7 Penalties on outstanding rates for property tax are levied as under:

7. (1) Penalties shall be levied in respect of property having total outstanding rates at the turn of the calendar year.
- (2) The amount of tax computed shall be increased by penalty calculated at 3 per cent compounded per month.
- (3) The County Executive Committee Member for Finance and Economic planning may waive the penalty imposed under this section SUBJECT to Article 210 of the Constitution of Kenya 2010.

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#### **Penalties on outstanding house rent**

8. A surcharge shall be levied for rental default at a cumulative rate of 2 % per month.

#### **Other penalties on outstanding business permits.**

9.(1) The penalty payable shall be the amount of license increased by a penalty calculated at 15 per cent compounded per month with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> April of every:

- (a) 25 per cent on the principal sum annually for businesses under category C,D and E as listed in part V (Appendices) of this Act.

(b) 30 per cent on the principal sum annually for businesses under category C,D and E as listed in part V (Appendices) of this Act.

9(2) The County Executive Committee Member for Finance and Economic planning may waive the penalty imposed under this section SUBJECT to article 210 of the Constitution of Kenya 2010.

**General penalty**

10. A person who commits an offence under this Act for which no penalty is provided shall be liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding Ten Thousand Kenya Shillings or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding six months or both.

**PART IV- MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS**

**Measures to prevent non-remittance of collected revenue.**

11. In order to ensure all revenue is remitted, the County Executive Committee Member responsible for Finance will issue directive:

- a) to make use of modern technology for collection and monitoring cash receipts,
- b) Digitalize all county mutations to allow prompt management of property liable to property tax.
- (c) To conduct county wide survey to establish revenue potential.
- (d) To put proper measures in place to prevent loss of revenue including recruitment of staff, training, surprise checks and visits to markets.
- (e) To make use of enforcement efforts, where necessary.

**Amendment to Schedules**

12(1) The County Executive Committee Member for Finance and Economic Planning may by order published in the gazette amend any of the schedules.

(2) Any order made under sub section (1) shall be laid before the County Assembly without unreasonable delay, and unless a resolution approving the order is passed by the County Assembly within the next twenty one days on which it next sits after the order is so laid, the order shall lapse but without prejudice to anything previously done there under.

**Regulations**

13. The County Executive Committee Member for Finance and Economic Planning may make regulations for the better carrying out of the purposes and provisions of this Act
