COMMUNICATION AS RELATES TO THE KITUI COUNTY LIVESTOCK BREEDS IMPROVEMENT POLICY AND THE AUDITOR GENERAL'S REPORT ON THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS OF KITUI WATER AND SANITATION COMPANY (KITWASCO)

Honourable Members

Article 185 (4) of the Constitution provides that the County Assembly may receive and approve plans for the development and management of its infrastructure and institutions.

It is for this reason that the County Executive Committee Member for Agriculture Water and Livestock Development submitted to the County Assembly, the Kitui County Livestock Breeds Improvement policy on 10th September, 2018.

The Kitui County Livestock Breeds Improvement policy has been developed to address issues of livestock breeds improvement within the sub sector for the people of Kitui County.

The programme to be implemented is aimed at unlocking the huge potential for increasing household incomes through livestock development and support of the value chain.

I therefore commit this policy to the Committee on Agriculture, Water and Irrigation for scrutiny and further consideration.

Article 229(8) of the Constitution provides that the County Assembly shall within three (3) months after receiving an audit report, debate and consider the report and take appropriate action.

I therefore commit the said Auditor General's report to the Committee on Public Investments and Accounts for further scrutiny and consideration.
